CONDITIONS OF DISPLAY

1. The official Ground Space Contract (hereinafter referred to as the Contract) shall be in the hands of the Secretary no later than 22nd August, 2008. However, late lodgment of same will be accepted subject to availability of display sites.
2. No Exhibitor shall assign, sub-let or part with the whole or any part of their allocated ground space, or purport to do so without the written consent of the Westtech Field Days Assoc. Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the Association).
3. Exhibitors are responsible for the condition of the space covered by their Contract during the currency of Westtech 2008 and, on the completion of Westtech 2008; Exhibitors shall clear such area to the satisfaction of the Association.
4. Exhibitors shall ensure that their displays are actively manned between the hours of 8:00AM and 5:00PM daily on Tuesday 9th and Wednesday 10th September, 2008.
5. No major structure or item on display shall be dismantled or removed from Exhibitor's sites before 5:00PM Wednesday 10th September 2008.
6. Reasonable security will be provided by the Association during the hours of darkness from Monday 8th to Wednesday 10th inclusive. The Association, however, shall not be held liable for loss or damage to any Exhibitor's property whilst on the said area.
7. The Association shall have the right to sell by public auction or private treaty or otherwise dispose of any structure or item remaining on the said area after an expiration of fourteen days from the completion of said Westtech 2008 and may retain for its own use the proceeds of any such disposal. The Association will however consider genuine applications for extension of time.
8. Should the Association find it necessary or expedient to cancel or postpone Westtech 2008, this Contract will cease to operate upon notice to that effect signed by an authorized member of the Association being served on the Exhibitor by mail to the address shown on the Contract. The Association shall not be liable to any Exhibitor for any compensation whatsoever in respect of such cancellation or postponement.
9. Exhibitors must cover their own Public Risk Liability on the Westtech 2008 grounds by an appropriate insurance policy. A minimum cover of \$10,000,000 (ten million dollars) has been recommended to cover exhibitors at the Barcaldine Showgrounds from the 8th to the 11th September 2008, and to include the principles (Westtech Field Days Assoc. Inc and the Barcaldine Shire Council). A certificate of currency must be provided to the Association before display sites will be allocated.
10. Exhibitors shall conform to the requirements of any Act of Parliament which may govern the erection of structures for the display and/or sale of machinery and/or other products or goods of the Exhibitor, as well as the Regulations, By-Laws and Ordinances made under such Act.
11. The Association reserves the right to publish Sponsor and Exhibitor contact details in the Westtech Field Day Product Information and Westtech website and to provide such details to the Associations' preferred advertising agencies.
12. Any member of the Association or other person appointed by the Association shall have the power to enter upon the space described at any time and order the removal of any object or other material which in his/her opinion is endangering public safety or is not eligible for display or may be the cause of offence.
13. No livestock, other than those specifically provided or approved by the Association shall be brought onto the grounds. Provisions covering the welfare of livestock and associated public safety are outlined in the Exhibitor Information section of the Westtech 2008 Prospectus and must be strictly adhered to.
14. The Association reserves the right to cancel this Contract at any time if there is, in the opinion of the Association, any infringement of these conditions.
15. Permission must be sought from the Westtech Committee for auctions to be conducted by Exhibitors at the Field Days and that a commission, negotiated by both parties, will be payable to the Association.
